Is this a high end "sippin" Bourbon, no, it isn't. Is it a great deal for the price, well that depends on whether you like it or not. But if you want an inexpensive Bourbon for use in cocktails it's one helluva deal.

You can get Jim Beam in just about every bar anywhere in the World, so there is no need for you to blow your cash without tasting it first.

Would I buy it? At that price, of course I would.

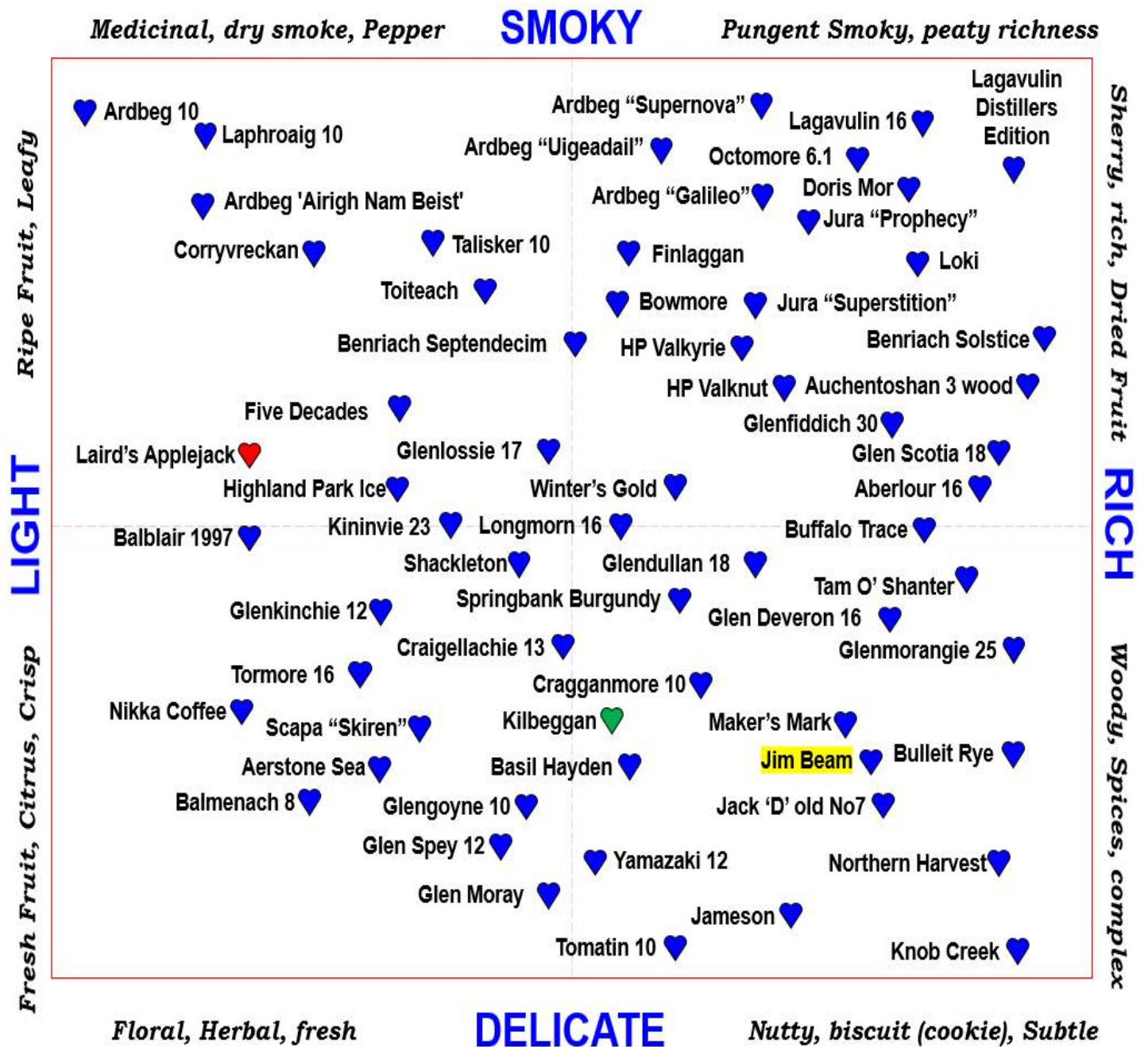
